Financial Assistance from the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation

Today, TEPCO received 18.6 billion yen in grants from the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation (“NDF”) according to the Special Business Plan, the modifications to which were approved on March 17, 2025.

We have previously received a total of 188.9 billion yen as indemnity payment according to the stipulations in the Act on Contract for Indemnification of Nuclear Damage Compensation and 11 trillion 323 billion yen as grants from the NDF by February 2025. We had applied for a request of funding for the 155th time, seeing that the compensation we were about to pay out by the end of April 2025 was about to exceed the total of these amounts. We submitted our 155th request for funding of 53.8 billion yen, of which 35.2 billion yen has already been received as the amount allocated for March (as announced on March 24). The amount we received today is the grant amount allocated for April.

With the financial assistance from the NDF, TEPCO is determined to work with each and every one of those who were affected by the nuclear accident with understanding and compassion for them.
