## Financial Assistance from the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation

Today, TEPCO received 4.7 billion yen in grants from the Nuclear Damage Compensation and Decommissioning Facilitation Corporation (“NDF”) according to the Special Business Plan, the modifications to which were approved on March 31, 2026.

We have previously received a total of 188.9 billion yen as indemnity payment according to the stipulations in the Act on Contract for Indemnification of Nuclear Damage Compensation and 11,500.3 billion yen as grants from the NDF. We had applied for a request of funding for the 168th time, seeing that the compensation we were about to pay out by the end of May 2026 was about the exceed the total of these amounts.

With the financial assistance from the NDF, TEPCO is determined to work with each and every one of those who were affected by the nuclear accident with understanding and compassion for them.
