

<Marine Organism Rearing Log>





Since the feed for flounders and abalones includes fish meal, the umami component is released from the feed as we continue rearing for a long time, and the rearing water becomes a soup color (golden yellow). It could be kept as it is, but we tried to decolorize it by adding activated charcoal to the tank to make it look better. The color is slowly fading.
