As the amount of food ingested is thought to be a major factor that determines the size of abalones, we have been working on different ways to get the food closer to the abalones. Remembering that we used to use a tube to drop feeds near the abalones, we tried this idea immediately. As a result, we are able to drop feeds closer to the abalones. It is a much more effective way than scattering the feeds from over the surface of water.
