Weather: Sunny

Water temperature: 18.0°C

When we started cultivating seaweed in May, we isolated the seaweed tank from the rest of the tanks to prevent it from being contaminated by microorganisms and bacteria that can harm marine organisms. Two and a half months have passed and we believe that this risk has decreased sufficiently, so today we removed the tank from isolation and returned it to its original place in the system.
