Progress with the dismantling of the J9 area tanks

- Dismantling of the welded tanks in the J9 area began on February 14, 2025. Today, a crane was used to hoist and remove two side plates that had been cut apart vertically.
- The side plates that were lowered to the ground will be stored in a container and cut up just like the top lid in order to reduce their size.
- This marks the first time a welded tank that stored ALPS treated water has been dismantled so we shall accumulate knowledge while confirming procedures, etc., and move forward with dismantling while prioritizing safety.
