Removal of all wall panels (18 in total) from the Unit 1 reactor building cover completed at Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

On November 10, the 18th wall panel was removed from Unit 1 reactor building cover, marking the completion of removing all of the wall panels.

From September 13 when the first panel was removed, no significant changes have been observed during the work at dust monitors measuring radioactivity concentrations and at monitoring posts installed along the site boundary.
