

# Status of compensation for nuclear damage

## 1. Status of payment of compensation (as of March 9)

### Amount of compensation

In addition to approx. 142 billion yen, which we have paid as temporary compensation since last May, the amount of the payment, which we have paid as permanent compensation since last October, is approx. 303.5 billion yen and therefore the total amount of the both is approx. 445.5 billion yen.

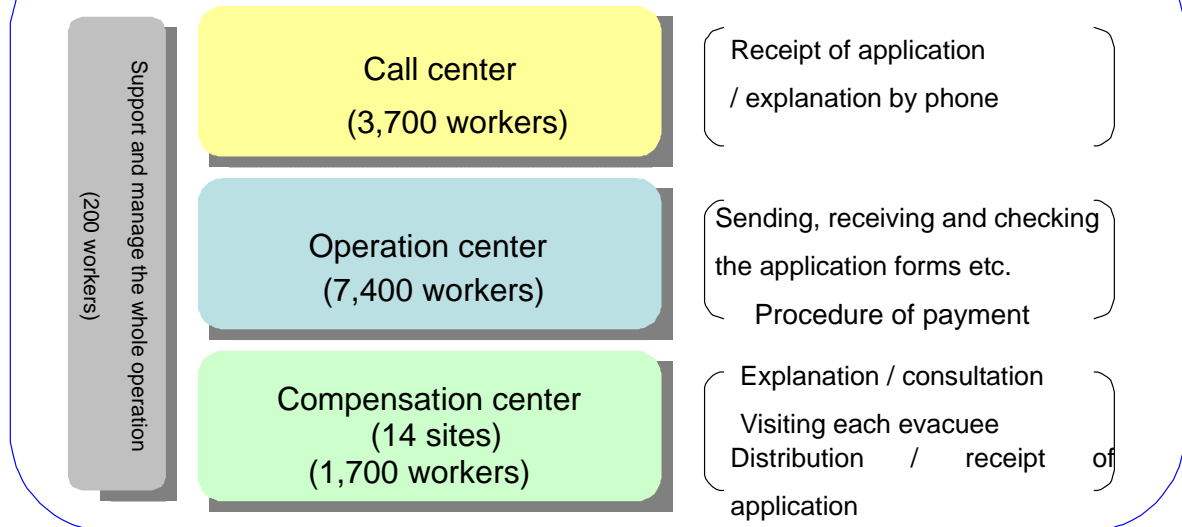

## 2. Increase of personnel for compensation

Compensation work originally began with approx. 1,000 of workers but in order to consult on the losses due to voluntary evacuation and so forth properly, now we have increased the number of the workers to approx. 13,100 (employees of TEPCO: 3,300).
