

Taiwan Electric Overview

1 . Comparison between Taiwan and TEPCO

2 . Electric power demand

Electricity demand is increasing, reflecting the steady growth of the Taiwanese economy. The amount of electricity sold in 1992 amounts to 85.3 TWh, and reached 181.6 TWh in 2006 (an average annual growth rate of approx.5.5% from 1992~2006) .

3 . Operating entity of electric power industry

Taiwan Power Company delivers electricity through an integrated system of power generation, transmission, and distribution throughout Taiwan. The government of Taiwan holds most of the shares, placing the company under the control of the Ministry of Economic Affairs.
