
Details of mistakes in parameters related to plants in Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station

1. Correction of errors based on Evidence Data<sup>\*1</sup> (Primary cause of mistakes in parameters related to plants (Summary Sheet\*<sup>2</sup>) and Data Sheets<sup>\*3</sup> is errors in posting.)

<Example of errors>(Summary Sheets: approx. 200 cases, Data Sheets: approx. 300 cases)

Figures in Summary Sheets and Data Sheets were different from those in evidence Data (errors in posting)



We will double-check in posting data to prevent mistakes.

2. Correction to adjust parameter data related to plants


<Example of main adjustments> (Summary Sheets; approx. 100 cases, Data Sheets: Approx. 5,000 cases)

- 1) Data newly confirmed are added to Data Sheets.
- 2) Description of hunting Data\*4 is now uniformed.

(In Data Sheets median is used for the ease of data processing such as graphical illustration.)



- 3) Other adjustments
  - (i) Figures rounded when they were posted from Evidence Data to Data Sheets and Summary Sheets are now corrected to figures in Evidence Data.
  - (ii) Times of data collection are corrected to those stated in Evidence Data



<sup>\*1:</sup>Evidence Data: Recorded figures of indicators mainly staff on duty observed in central control rooms and

through satellite cameras.

- \*2: Summary Sheet: Parameters related to plants summarized by day or time in one sheet, which is periodically reported to NISA. (They are available since April 18.)
- \*3:Data Sheet: Sheets parameters related to plants are chronologically summarized.
- \*4:Hunting data: Erratic data which vary within certain ranges, not showing becoming constant.
