Medical system (From September)

We have decided to continue the operation of the Emergency Medical Room at Unit 5/6 Service Building, which was established for heat disorder for the summer season (July to September), and to continuously assign doctors familiar with emergency medical care.

- Enhancing of medical function by assigning nurses (nonscheduled assignment for the time being)
- Enhancing of screening and decontamination and direct transfer of seriously injured persons without contamination to hospitals

Enhancement of health management for the workers by assigning doctors from Univ. of Occupational & Environmental Health, Japan or Labors' Hospital at J Village (preventive inoculation against influenza, etc.)
