

Solar Surcharge and Renewable Energy Surcharge for FY2014

- Based on the “Surplus electricity buyback program for the photovoltaic power generation”, the purchase cost of July 2012 is charged as the “Photovoltaic power promotion surcharge” (hereafter the “solar surcharge”) in April to September 2014.
- In line with the completion of the transition of the “Surplus electricity buyback program for the photovoltaic power generation” to the “Fixed price purchasing scheme for renewable energy”, the solar surcharge will be terminated with the charge for September 2014.
- In accordance with the “Fixed price purchasing scheme for renewable energy”, the “Renewable energy power promotion surcharge” (hereafter the “renewable energy surcharge”) calculated based on the renewable energy surcharge unit price for FY 2013 (0.35 yen/kWh) will be continuously added onto the electricity charge for April 2014. Also, the “renewable energy surcharge” calculated based on the renewable energy surcharge unit price for FY2014 will be added onto the electricity charges during the period from May 2014 to April 2015. (Details are to be announced by the Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry)
- Thus, both the “solar surcharge” and the “renewable energy surcharge” will be charged along with the electricity bills for April to September 2014.
